## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THE FIRST SCHOOL DAY:

Please Note - New Morning Routine: This year, students can enter the building 5 minutes earlier at 7:40 a.m. Upon arrival, students will visit their lockers to drop off belongings (including cell phones) and pick up materials for their morning classes before reporting to homeroom. Breakfast will be served in homerooms free of charge for ALL students between 7:40-7:55. The bell will ring at 7:57 for students to transition from homeroom to 1<sup>st</sup> period. First period and the official school day begins at 8:00 a.m. Students who are not present in their 1<sup>st</sup> period class at 8:00 a.m. will be marked tardy for the school day.

Students should be at the bus stop a few minutes early (5-10 minutes), as route times can fluctuate during the first few weeks of school. **PLEASE DO NOT ASSUME THAT THE BUS SCHEDULE/NUMBER WILL BE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.** Schedules, bus numbers, and drivers can change from year to year.

**School Lunches:** The cost of a middle school student lunch remains at \$3.25. (Breakfast is free at WLMS). - Medical information
- Arrival/dismissal procedures
- Media release (photo approval)
- Data confidentiality
- PTA/PTSA directory
