### New Student Orientation - Thursday, August 30th at 12:30

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THE FIRST SCHOOL DAY - Tuesday, September 4th

**Please Note - New Morning Routine:** This year, students can enter the building **5 minutes earlier at 7:40 a.m**. Upon arrival, students will visit their lockers to drop off belongings (including cell phones) and pick up materials for their morning classes before reporting to homeroom. Breakfast will be served in homerooms free of charge for ALL students between 7:40-7:55. The bell will ring at 7:57 for students to transition from homeroom to 1<sup>st</sup> period. First period and the official school day begins at 8:00 a.m. Students who are not present in their 1<sup>st</sup> period class at 8:00 a.m. will be marked tardy for the school day.

Students should be at the bus stop a few minutes early (5-10 minutes), as route times can fluctuate during the first few weeks of school. **PLEASE DO NOT ASSUME THAT THE BUS SCHEDULE/NUMBER WILL BE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.** Schedules, bus numbers, and drivers can change from year to year.

**School Lunches:** The cost of a middle school student lunch remains at \$3.25. (Breakfast is free at WLMS). Once logged in, parents/guardians will be asked to provide or update the following information:

- Student information
- Parent/guardian contact
- Emergency contacts
- Medical information
- Arrival/dismissal procedures
- Media release (photo approval)
- Data confidentiality
- PTA/PTSA directory

# Health Room Reminders:

\* All incoming 7th grades MUST provide documentation that they have received a single dose of Tdap AND a single dose of Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4). This became a Maryland State Department of Health and Mental Hygiene requirement in 2014. If you received a letter attached to your child's report card at the end of the 2017-18 school year – THIS REMINDER IS FOR YOU! If you are not sure, contact the Health Room.

\* If your student requires daily or emergency medications for use at school please be sure to bring: -A completed Medication Order Form (including the physician and parent signatures)

-Prescription medication MUST have current prescription pharmacy label and must match the order form.

-Over the counter medication MUST be in an unopened container (the smaller the container, the better as they will be packed for field trips throughout the school year).

-All "first doses" of medications MUST be given by the parent at home so parents can monitor student closely for any adverse side effects.

\* If your student starting the school year with a recent injury and has activity restrictions (i.e. wearing and cast, needing to use crutches, recent surgery etc) please send in all physician documentation and/or orders for accommodations that will be needed to start the school year.
