Student Engagement - As the May weather settles down and we compete with sunshine and warmer temps student attendance is beginning to slip in Google Meets. I recognize it's been shared that Google Meets are not mandatory if students are able to accurately complete their assignments, however they are a consistent way to gain access to clarifying questions, have discourse with peers, and stay engaged in the learning process. We are noticing a trend of students not attending Google Meets and then sending emails to staff late in the week scrambling to gain clarity prior to assignment submission. Please encourage your student to not only attend the Google Meets but to actively engage in the discussion. I don't want our students to miss out on the opportunity to engage with peers, staff, and extend their thinking. We need to support them in keeping the routines of Brick and Mortar Wilde Lake the best we can while the Virtual Lake is in session.

End of The Year - Many parents have inquired about the EOY timeline, picking up items your student left behind, Memory Books, Spring pictures, and 8th Grade Celebrations. We currently have the school pictures at the Lake and once decisions are made with the guidelines and timeline of how students can return and pick up items at school we will reach out.
