What does it mean to be enrolled in a high school credit course in middle school?

Students and families should know:

- 1. Content presented is **high school material**
- Students will need to earn a final grade for the course that is passing to earn credit high school credit. (Policy 8020)- average D must be 0.75 or greater for credit to be awarded.
- 3. The midterm assessment will be included in 2nd quarter grades
- 4. The **final** assessment will be included in 4th quarter grades
- 5. Final grade for the course will appear on the high school transcript but WILL NOT be calculated into the high school GPA.

- Parents of rising 7th and 8th graders will choose two Selected Course Requests. One of these
 must meet the fine arts requirement (Band, Chorus, Orchestra, General Music, Theater, or
 Visual Arts Studio). Choose two Selected Alternate Course Requests to be used if an elective
 is not available or there is a scheduling conflict.
- The first alternate course request will be used as a primary request should HCPSS continue the 4x4 schedule next year.
