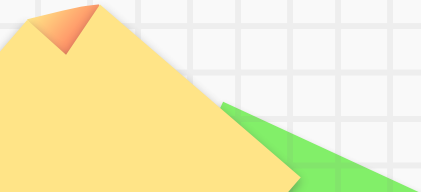

# WLMS Attendance

- Increased student attendance is a piece of our school improvement plan - we want to see your children every day!
- Daily instruction starts at 8:30am
- If your child is absent from school, please e-mail [wlmsabsence@hcpss.org](mailto:wlmsabsence@hcpss.org) with any documentation
- **\*NEW\* for 24-25** - no early dismissals within the last 15 minutes of the school day
  - You are required to show your ID every time

# Cell Phones & Earbuds



- Students may NOT use cell phones or wear earbuds/headphones during school.
- Students must turn cell phones off and place them in their lockers or backpacks before going to 1st period, and they must remain out of sight until dismissal at 3:15 PM.
- Students assume full responsibility for their devices.

# WLMS Breakfast

- **Program Overview**

The breakfast program is an opportunity for all students to eat breakfast every morning here at Wilde Lake. Students do not need to eat the breakfast we provide, but they may not bring in their own food or drinks **(NO STARBUCKS - SAVE YOUR \$\$)**. This is a violation of the grant.

# Lunch at WLMS



- G6 lunch time - 11:17am on regular days, 11:30am on Wednesdays
- Lunch payments go through:

- Free and reduced meal applications must be resubmitted (every year - 1 per family)
  - Hard copies will be sent home on the first day of school
- No DoorDash/food delivery orders will be accepted at the school
- If you are dropping off a lunch for your student, there will be a cart in the main office vestibule

# Bus Numbers & Bus Stops

- **Be at least 5 min early at bus stop**
- Expect late pick-up/drop-off on the first day of school

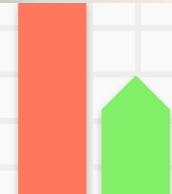

# What does my child need?

- Day 1 - pencils and paper
  - Students will learn more about what school supplies are needed for each of their classes during the first week.
- After Chromebooks have been distributed, students should always bring their fully charged Chromebook.
  - Unless your child has an accomodation no personal devices can be used during the school day (leave ipads/tablets at home)



# Chromebooks

- All students will be assigned a Chromebook for academic use.
  - Students are responsible for keeping their Chromebook safe.
- After they have been distributed, Chromebooks need to be brought everyday.
  - Please remember to charge your device the night before.
- What if student forget their Chromebook?
  - We have limited daily loaners. Students **MUST** borrow a Chromebook during 1st Period (or later - if they arrive with a late pass).



# When Can I Use My Locker?



- Upon Arrival
- Before/After Lunch
- At Dismissal
- With teacher permission & a pass
- Quickly between classes if you won't be tardy

# Canvas Codes: What does any of this mean?

- MI (Missing/Can Be Turned In - red)
  - Will calculate as a zero until submitted
- A for Absent (purple)
  - Should clarify with teacher about making up
- - (dash)
  - Signifies assigned has been created, may have been turned in but is in the process of being graded
- Schoolwide: 1 week Grace Period after the due date before assignment locks
  - Please note adjustments will be made for students with extended time

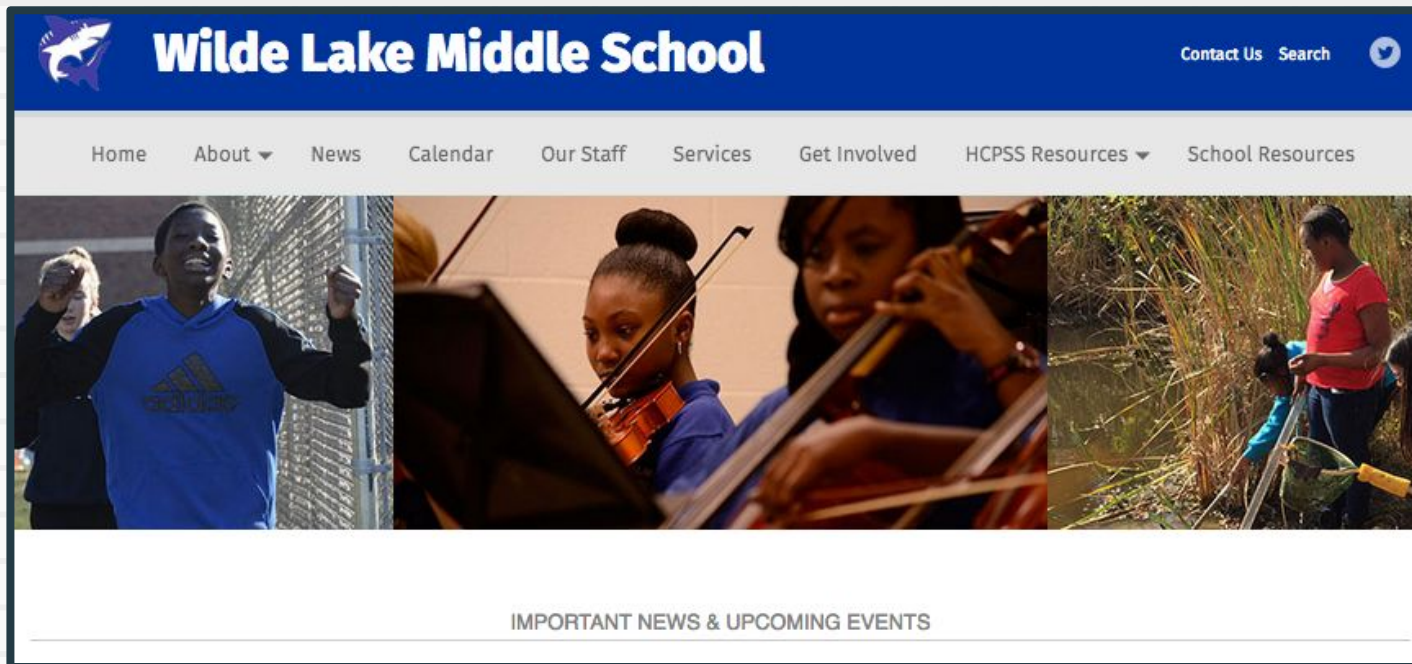

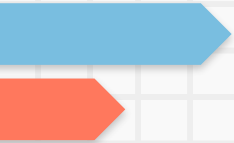
