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### End of year reminders from the Health Room:

All incoming 7<sup>th</sup> grade students for the 2021 – 2022 school year are mandated by the state of Maryland to have the following additional vaccines: <u>MCV4</u> (Meningococcal) and <u>Tdap</u> (tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis booster). If the Health Room does not have record of this you should have received either an email and/or a letter home (if your student is attending school in person). Please check your email "in boxes" and contact the Health Room if you have any questions. We must have this documentation **BEFORE** the first day of school (August 30, 2021). \*

If you anticipate that your student will need medication in the Health Room for the 2021 – 2022 school year please be sure all medication orders are dated after <u>July 1, 2021</u>. While COVID restrictions are slowly being lifted we continue to have our students and their families health and well being in our goals for the future. A few reminders to staying well over the summer:

- <u>Proper and frequent handwashing is a MUST</u> and the best way to prevent illness of any sort, including COVID and it's variants, so keep washing those hands!
- Keep hands and fingers away from eyes, nose and mouth.
- Stay home if you are sick and if you are having COVID like symptoms (fever of 100.4 or higher, sore throat, cough, difficulty breathing, diarrhea or vomiting, new onset of severe headache (especially with fever), or new loss of taste or smell ... stay home and away from household members as best you can and consider getting tested (PCR is still the most accurate).
- Consider getting the COVID vaccine for your student as they are now being offered for persons 12 years of age and older.
- Rest and get plenty of outdoor time in your daily schedule!! And don't forget that sunscreen!
