Happy Friday WLMS community!

I am pleased to announce that HCPSS has set a window of opportunity to allow students and families to retrieve personal items that may have been left at the Lake since March 13 or drop off items for those students who are not returning to HCPSS in 20-21. In an effort to ensure we have developed a schedule that meets the needs of our community while upholding all safety measures we are asking that you complete the following survey by Monday, June 1, 2020.

Students with school system property such as Chromebooks, band and orchestra instruments, textbooks, media books, or other materials and supplies belonging to HCPSS are being asked to hold onto the materials until school resumes in school buildings.

Once school resumes in school buildings, students will bring their school system property to whatever school they attend and it will be collected and redistributed to its original location. There is nothing that families need to do, even if your student is being redistricted or your student is moving to a new school within HCPSS.

Students leaving HCPSS, regardless of grade, will need to return HCPSS property during their designated time provided.

Below are some highlights and key information regarding the survey and opportunity:

- Please fill out this form to inform us of essential items that you need our staff to retrieve from the school building.
- No student or parent will be permitted to enter the building. No exceptions.
- If you are not able to come to the school to pick up personal items left in a locker, those items will remain in a secure location at WLMS till Fall when the students return or have another opportunity get their belongings.
- If your student is **not** returning to HCPSS for the 2020/2021 school year, you will also use this form to indicate the types of items that you will need to drop off.
- Students returning to WLMS or any other HCPSS school for the 2020/2021 school year should plan to hold onto school system property until we return. *This includes library books and Chromebooks*.
- Please remember that all social distancing measures MUST remain in place at all times when the date is given to pick up items. A detailed plan will be sent to all families who respond along with the schedule prior to the day of pick up and drop off.
- If you have multiple children that need to either pick up or drop off items, please fill out a form for each student.
