Dear Family and Friends of Wilde Lake Middle School,

What a pleasure it was to see so many parents attend our Back to School Night on Thursday evening. The support of parents along with school staff is an invaluable partnership, that leads to successful experiences for students. The WLMS staff is excited to work with your students this school year, and we are vested in their growth and development.

At this time it is critical for any 7th grade student who has not turned in the appropriate immunization documentation to do so before school begins on Monday, September 15th. Failure to show proof of the needed immunizations will result in exclusion from school effective MONDAY, September 15, 2014. This means your child will not be allowed to attend school until these records are received. Our Health Room staff has been working diligently to contact families and provide resources so that these new requirements do not effect our students, but we do still have incomplete records at this time. We encourage families that have the documentation, to come to school on Monday with the their students and report to our Health Suite, to submit the needed documentation.

On Tuesday and Wednesday of this week, our awesome counselors, Ms. Berla and Ms. Cornelius will visit all 6th graders to conduct lessons on positive interactions with peers. This lesson is a part of the counseling curriculum, and in the past has proven to spark great conversations and insights. Take time to follow up with your sixth grader about what they discussed.


